

Annual Graduate Student Award Guidelines:

An annual ANSC graduate award will be given to an outstanding student based on three criteria: (1) performance of duties as a T.A.; (2) strong academic performance; and (3) outstanding contributions in the research laboratory. Students would be considered only after being nominated by any ANSC faculty. Nominations would include letter(s) of support from the major advisor, associate advisors and/or faculty who have observed the student in any of the three areas (e.g. the student T.A.'d their class). Nominations will be evaluated by the Graduate Committee in August (following submission of the annual reports). Any member of the Graduate Committee who is either advisor to the student, or who has submitted a letter of support, shall excuse him/herself from voting.
